Celebrate MLK Day of Service with King County Parks and People For Puget Sound at one of the most stunning King County beach parks. January can be cold, but often that means clear skies and a beautiful view of Mount Rainier. Maury Island Marine Park is a former gravel mine that has seen decades of soil disruption and invasive plant growth. People For Puget Sound and King County have been working with volunteers on revegetating the shoreline with native plants since 2009.

Come help plant trees!

We'll be there rain or shine so dress for the weather (rain gear in case of bad weather or sunglasses and a hat if it's sunny). Wear your sturdiest, most waterproof foot gear (sneakers, hiking boots, etc. **No sandals**). Wearing long trousers and long sleeves is advisable since we will be in the weeds. Bring lunch and your own work gloves if you have them. **We provide work gloves, tools, snacks, and water (bring your own water bottle).**
